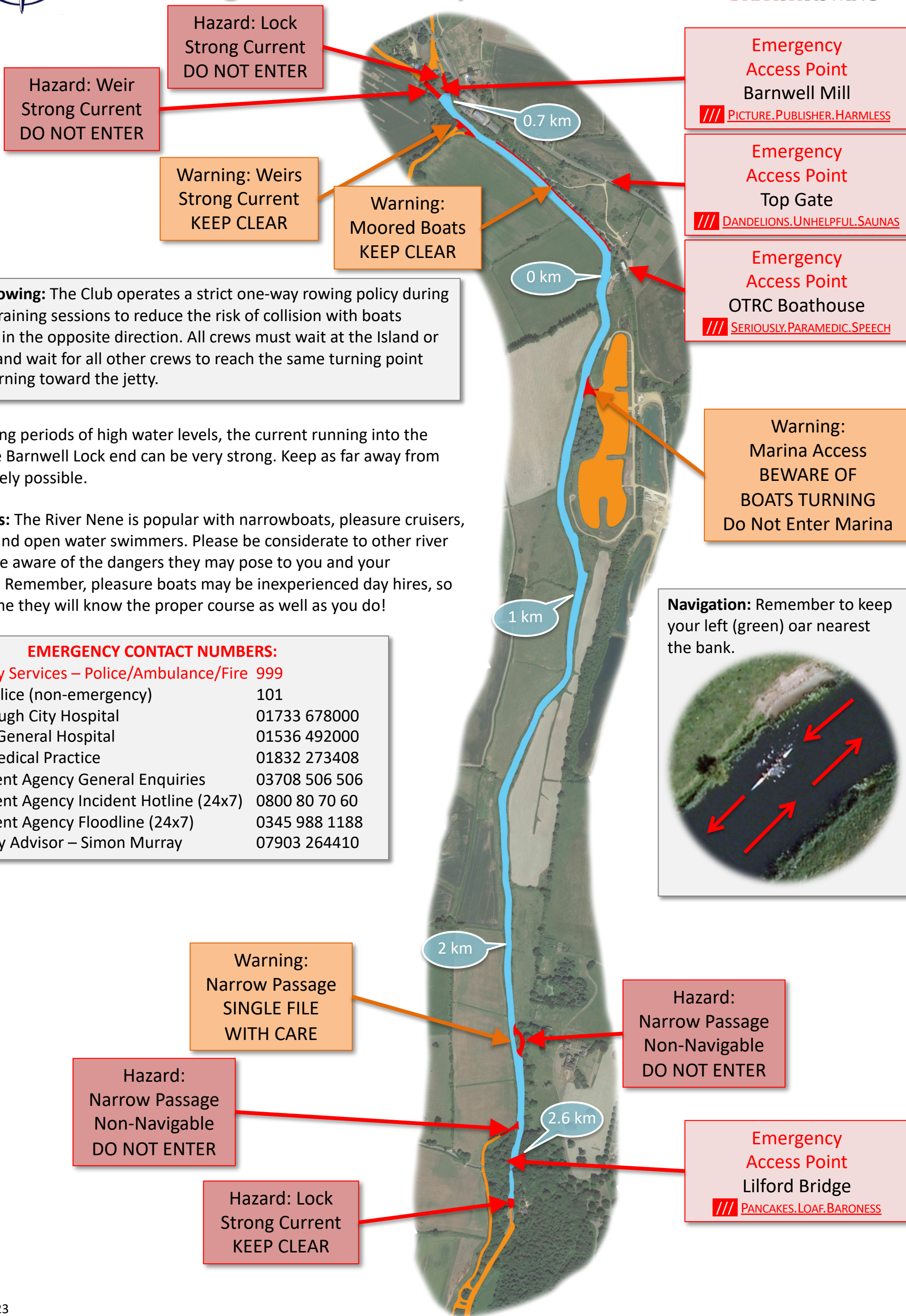




Oundle Town Rowing Club

Navigation & Safety Information



One-way Rowing: The Club operates a strict one-way rowing policy during organised training sessions to reduce the risk of collision with boats proceeding in the opposite direction. All crews must wait at the Island or at the Mill and wait for all other crews to reach the same turning point before returning toward the jetty.

Weirs: During periods of high water levels, the current running into the weirs at the Barnwell Lock end can be very strong. Keep as far away from them as safely possible.

Other Boats: The River Nene is popular with narrowboats, pleasure cruisers, canoeists, and open water swimmers. Please be considerate to other river users and be aware of the dangers they may pose to you and your equipment. Remember, pleasure boats may be inexperienced day hires, so don't assume they will know the proper course as well as you do!
